- Seminars & Workshops on state of art Technology in Surveying and Mapping.


- More than 90 batches of the 2-year courses have passed out since its inception.

Delineation of the **Hazard Line** along the entire coast of India is part of the many goals and objectives of the ICZM project








ICZM seeks, over the long-term, to balance environmental, economic, social, cultural and recreational objectives, all within the limits set by natural dynamics



ICZM - PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- 0.5 m elevation contour map upto a width of 7km on 1:10,000 scale to serve as base map.
- 3-D digital elevation model (DEM).
- Tidal data Analysis.
- Composite **Hazard Line** by overlaying Flood Line & Erosion Line.
